RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Any resident of Manitoba (who is 18 years or older) may become a member of the Society, must provide his / her name and mailing address and payment of one dollar membership fee annually. Treherne Agricultural Society membership will be due annually at the annual meeting.
2. Exhibitors are requested to have all inside entries entered by 10:30 a.m. the first day of the fair (Exception: See Livestock) **Entries accepted from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Positively no entries accepted after 10:30 a.m.**
3. All inside exhibits must be in the building no later than 10:30 a.m. the **first day of the fair** and shall stay there until the close of the Exhibition. **The building closes to the public at 5:00 p.m. the last day of the fair** and exhibits can be removed at 5:30 p.m. **All livestock must be on the grounds no later than 10:00 a.m. the last morning of the show and shall remain until 5:30.**
4. All entries must be the property of, be grown by, or be the work of the exhibitor; in the case of grains, horticulture, food, clothing and fine arts, the work shall be new and produced or completed since the previous Treherne Fair. **Exhibits not accepted by mail.**
5. No animals or article shall be allowed to compete in more than one section of a class (certain exceptions in livestock) except for Championships and Specials.
6. All entry fees must be paid with entry.
7. Entry tags will be provided to exhibitors and must remain attached to all exhibits.
8. Name or marks indicating name of the owners must not appear on anything until judging is completed.
9. Exhibits, which may have been erroneously entered, may, at the discretion of the judge and director in charge, be transferred to the proper classes previous to judging. Exhibits not officially entered will be disqualified.
10. In the absence of competition, the judges may award first, second or no prize, according to the merit of the exhibit and shall have it in their power to withhold any premium of any animal or article which they may consider unworthy of same, or prize money may be reduced to 75%.
11. No person shall interfere with the judges while in the discharge of their duty. Any breach of this rule on the part of an exhibitor will disentitle the exhibitor to a prize in such a case.
12. The judge's decision in all cases shall be final, unless appealed from as hereinafter provided. Every appeal must be in writing and lodged with the Secretary while class and judges are still on the grounds and must be accompanied by \$5.00 for each appeal in question, which will be returned to the exhibitor if the appeal is sustained. Parties openly objecting to a decision in any case shall forfeit all claims to prizes they would otherwise have obtained.
13. Judging shall commence; **Saturday:** Inside exhibits 1:00 P.M., **Sunday:** 4-H Beef Club Achievement 9:00 A.M., Fancy Lady & Jack-pot classes 1:00 P.M. Beef Cattle Show approximately 2:00 P.M., 4-H Steer Sale 4:30 P.M.
14. The directors reserve the final and absolute right to interpret, enforce, or add to the forgoing rules and regulations, and violation shall be subject to such penalties as the Directors shall prescribe.

15. No new classes added, unless at the decision of the executive and the directors in charge of that class.
16. All livestock prize money will be paid out in the form of cash or mailed out by Treasurer. Any cheques must be cashed within 60 days from date issue.
17. The directors will not be responsible for any animal or article injured, lost or stolen, but will render assistance in protecting and recovering the same.
18. Any additional "Specials" or cancellation of any "Specials" and correction of any printing error will appear in The Treherne Times in the issue, the second week of June.

RULES AND REGULATIONS APPLYING TO LIVESTOCK
PREMISE ID # MB1044324

1. Where entries justify, classes should be provided for each breed of livestock. However, if not enough entries or competition the different breeds will show against each other.
2. All livestock must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and have been so far at least 30 days prior to the date of the fair.
3. All exhibits in the cattle classes must be shown and judged in the ring.
4. All bulls (over 1 year old), must be ringed or on a leader.
5. All cows shall be shown with their own calf at foot.
7. Calves born January 1 and later (of current year) can be shown in a calf class and with its mother in the cow / calf class.
8. If there is a Breed Association Show, no cross entry into Beef Cattle Show, except for the Jack-pot classes, and Fancy Lady Classic.
9. All cattle entered may be subject to veterinary examination if the directors in charge deem necessary. The exhibition committee may immediately order the removal from the grounds, of any animal showing evidence of an infectious or contagious disease.
10. Once entries have been made, a \$5.00 charge will be made for each and any changes made to entries with the exception of scratching an entry.
11. Entries must be made by 10:30 the day of the cattle show, unless for breed show if specified.
