

Manitoba YCSA Scholarship

The Manitoba YCSA Scholarship has been established by the Manitoba Simmental Association and the Manitoba YCSA to support deserving Manitoba youth. The scholarship is administered jointly by both organizations, via a 'Scholarship Committee' with representatives named to the committee by the Board of Directors of MSA and MYCSA. The decisions of the Scholarship Committee shall be final.

Application Guidelines:

- 1. Open to MYCSA members and/or children of Manitoba CSA members.
- 2. Applicants will be no older than 25 years old as of January 1 of the application year.
- 3. Qualified applicants will be pursuing a post-secondary education, preferably in an Agriculture related field.
- 4. Qualified applicants should demonstrate a strong level of activity within the Manitoba Simmental beef industry and/or Manitoba Young Canadian Simmental events.
- 5. Qualified applicants should demonstrate an above level of interest in academic achievement.
- 6. The applicant must include a copy of their most current post-secondary academic year transcripts and/or a letter of acceptance to a post-secondary institution along with their latest high-school transcript.
- 7. Applicants will be reviewed by a group of at least 3 persons as selected by the Manitoba Simmental Association Board of Directors and the Manitoba YCSA Board of Directors.
- 8. Successful applicants will be asked to confirm enrollment in the Winter semester of their chosen post-secondary program.
- 9. Successful applicants are not eligible to reapply in future years.
- 10. Applications should be returned to the Manitoba Simmental Association by December 31st of the application year, addressed as follows:
